Report on Organ Donation Awareness

<u>Activities (03 - 17 August 2023)</u>

Introduction: Organ Donation Awareness is a crucial initiative aimed at promoting the importance of organ donation in saving lives. A series of activities were conducted in the village from 3rd August to 17th August 2023 to raise awareness about organ donation and encourage the community to participate in this life-saving cause.



Activities

1. Speech: Date: 03 August 2023 A speech on organ donation and its significance was delivered by a Faculty and medical expert at college and local community center. The speech emphasized the critical shortage of organs and the positive impact that organ donation can have on individuals in need of transplants.



2. Seminar: Date: 03 August 2023 A comprehensive seminar was organized in college hall, bringing together nursing staff and students. The seminar covered various aspects of organ donation, including the medical process, legal aspects, and the emotional journey of both donors and recipients.





3. Pledge Drive: Date: 03 August 2023 A pledge drive was held in the college, where staff and students were encouraged to sign up as organ donors. Informational booths and pamphlets were set up to address questions and concerns, and volunteers helped interested individuals complete the necessary paperwork.





4. Poster Competition: Date: 03 to 04 August 2023 Local schools participated in a poster competition centered around the theme of organ donation. The creative and thought-provoking posters were displayed in college, PHC and CMHO Office in Hanumangarh, effectively engaging both students and nursing professionals.





5. Health Talks: Date: 07 August 2023 Health talks were conducted by nursing staff and professionals at the local clinic and community spaces. These talks covered topics such as the benefits of organ donation, myths and misconceptions, and the role of organ donors in shaping a healthier future for society.





6. School education programme: Date: 11 August 2023 The school health talk on organ donation took place at Govt. Sr. Sec. School, Manaksar, Hanumangarh. The aim of the talk was to raise awareness among students and faculty members about the significance of organ donation, the types of donation, the process involved, and to dispel common myths surrounding the topic.









7. Role Play: Date: 11 August 2023 A group of dedicated student volunteers organized a role-playing event in rural community area & school in which participants acted out scenarios related to organ donation. This interactive approach helped convey complex ideas in an engaging and relatable manner.





8.Banner & Pamphlet Advertising: Dates: Throughout the awareness campaign Banners advocating for organ donation were strategically placed in high-traffic areas throughout the village and in and around college premises. The banners featured compelling messages and visuals to capture the attention of passersby and reinforce the importance of the cause.









9. Awareness Rally: Date: 17th August 2023 The awareness campaign concluded with a vibrant rally through the village streets. Participants carried banners, placards and distributed informational pamphlets, and engaged with onlookers to spread the message of organ donation.









Conclusion: The series of activities carried out between 3rd and 17th August 2023 effectively raised awareness about organ donation in the college, community and school. By utilizing a variety of approaches such as speeches, seminars, pledge drives, competitions, health talks, role plays, banner advertising, pamphlet distribution and a lively rally along Social media like Facebook, Youtube the community and public was informed and motivated to consider becoming organ donors. These efforts contributed significantly to fostering a culture of compassion and solidarity, highlighting the potential to save lives through the selfless act of organ donation.
